

Candidates can become child analysts after they have completed their adult cases though we encourage candidates to treat children or adolescents under supervision alongside their adult cases. Our new integrated training permits graduates of the adult psychoanalytic training to become child/adolescent analysts after their didactic portion is finished, so they do not have to do a separate child analytic training. Having knowledge of past, present and future of our patients by gaining experience of patients from all phases of development is more likely to ensure a full and rich psychoanalytic practice as well as a more nuanced developmental understanding of all patients.
